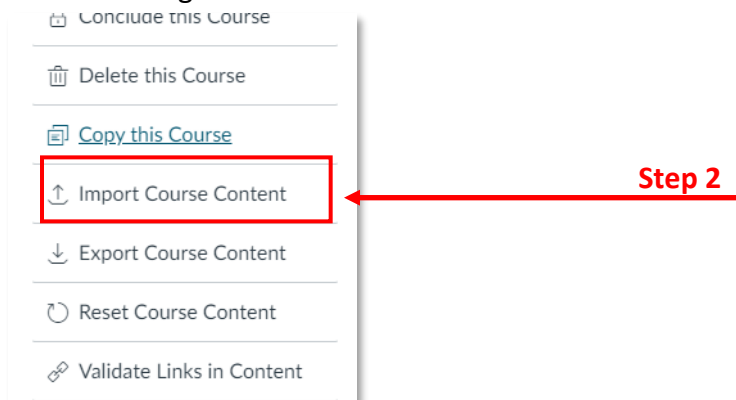


## Importing the APA Module to a Course

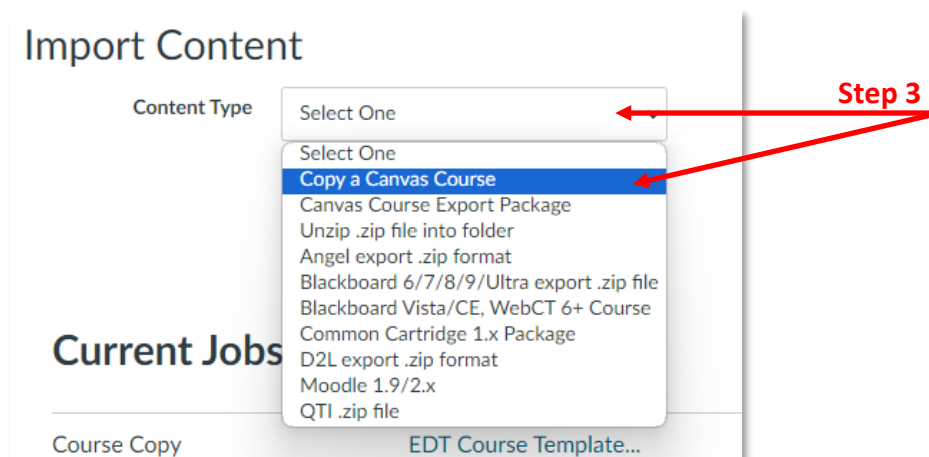
1. Go to **Settings** in your course.



2. Click **Import Course Content** from the right-hand side menu.



3. Select **Copy a Canvas Course** from the drop-down menu.



- 4. Search for **APA.LIBRARY.RESOURCE.COURSE.**
- 5. Check **Select specific content.**
- 6. Click **Import.**

- 7. Click **Select Content.** This step may take a few minutes, please allow some time if the Select Content button doesn't show up immediately.

- 8. Under **Modules**, select **APA LIBRARY RESOURCE MODULE Fall 23.**
- 9. Click **Select Content.**

10. The import is now completed.


