


1. Navigate to your course and click Assignments.




2. Click to open the assignment with the **Turnitin** settings.

4. Click to view the percentage to see the Turnitin Report in the Turnitin window.





5. When you open the Turnitin report you may see two different views, Classic View or Beta View. Beta View is the newer version of Turnitin which provides expanded options for the similarity report. If you see the Beta View you can switch to Classic View by clicking the option on the bottom. The last page of this handout contains information regarding the Classic View.





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
