An innovative advanced pain management certificate for certified registered nurse anesthetists. This course sequence is designed to improve patient care and accessibility to care through knowledge and education regarding advanced pain management.

- Convenient program with majority of courses online
- Five sequential courses completed throughout three consecutive semesters
- Utilizes evidence-based guidelines in understanding and treating both acute and chronic pain
- Addresses concept of pain beyond traditional views of interpretation and modulation of nociceptive impulses



Participants of the certificate will have skills labs held at The Center for Advanced Medical Learning and Simulation, a 90,000 square foot, state-of-the-art, three story facility with every possible form of health professional education and training, for individuals and teams.

- NGR 6471 Concepts of Pain Pathophysiology
- NGR 6472 Pharmacology of Pain Management
- NGR 6473 Interventional Procedures/Simulation in Pain
- NGR 647C Pain Management Clinical Residency

NOTE: Class size limited to 30 students yearly.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

- Board certified CRNA with an appropriate graduate degree from a regionally accredited university
- Minimum 3.0 GPA on all course work
- Minimum two years experience as a CRNA
- Submission of transcripts from graduate CRNA program
- Copy of an active NBCRNA card
- Letter of interest from the applicant
- Letter of reference from a clinical colleague
