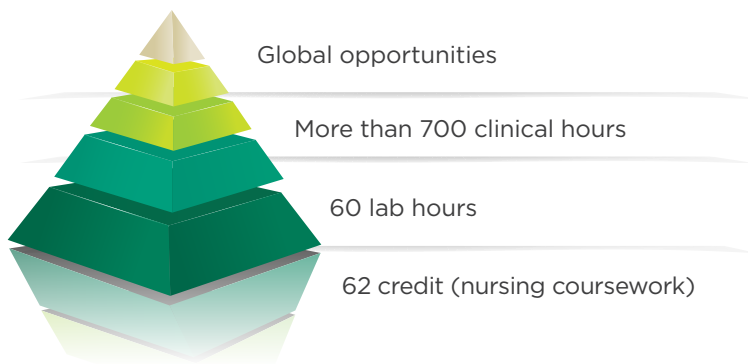

ACCREDITATION

The baccalaureate degree program in nursing, master’s degree program in nursing, and Doctor of Nursing Practice program at the University of South Florida are accredited by the *Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education, 655 K Street, NW, Suite 750, Washington, DC 20001, (202) 887-6791.*

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA on undergraduate coursework
- ✓ Completion of at least seven of the eight nursing prerequisite courses by the published deadline for the intended term of entry
Note: The one outstanding nursing prerequisite must be completed with a B grade or better by the program start date
- ✓ Completion of a bachelor’s degree from a regionally accredited institution by the program start date for the intended term of entry
- ✓ Online application to the College of Nursing by the application deadline upon completion of above requirements

NOTE: Admission is based on cumulative GPA, first-attempt grades in prerequisites, and an interview to identify motivations for pursuing nursing and professional approach to potential clinical scenarios

PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

Prerequisite courses must be completed with a “C” or better

- Anatomy & Physiology I and II with labs (8 hours)
- Microbiology with lab (4 hours)
- Statistics (3 hours)
- Human Nutrition (3 hours)
- Human Growth & Development or Life Cycle (3 hours)
- Any Chemistry, Biology, Biochemistry or Physics (3 hours)
- Any Psychology or Sociology (3 hours)
