ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA on undergraduate coursework
- Completion of at least seven of the eight nursing prerequisite courses by the published deadline for the intended term of entry
 - Note: The one outstanding nursing prerequisite must be completed with a B grade or better by the program start date
- Completion of the university's foreign language requirement
- Online application to the College of Nursing by the application deadline upon completion of above requirements

NOTE: Admission is based on cumulative GPA, firstattempt grades in prerequisites and an interview to identify motivations for pursuing nursing and professional approach to potential clinical scenarios

PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

Prerequisite courses must be completed with a "C" or better

Anatomy & Physiology I and II with labs (8 hours)

Microbiology with lab (4 hours)

Statistics (3 hours)

Human Nutrition (3 hours)

Human Growth & Development or Life Cycle (3 hours)
