ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Admission to University of South Florida (Tampa) as a degree-seeking undergraduate student
- Minimum 3.0 GPA on all undergraduate coursework
- Completion of the nursing prerequisite courses before the program start date
 - Note: Any outstanding nursing prerequisite past the nursing application deadline must be completed with a B grade or better by the program start date
- Completion of the university's foreign language and general education requirements before the program start date
- Submission of the College of Nursing SOAR application before the deadline listed on the V-CARE website

Note: Late applications will not be considered

NOTE: Admission is based on overall GPA, nursing prerequisites, a professional resume, and an interview to identify motivations for pursuing nursing and professional approach to potential clinical scenarios

PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

Prerequisite courses must be completed with a "C" or better
