

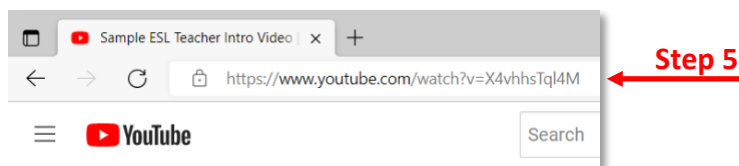
Generating Transcripts For YouTube Videos in Kaltura

Users can take publicly available YouTube videos and have it "hosted" within Kaltura. While it does not change ownership of the videos, as long as the video continues to be available on YouTube users can leverage the advanced functionality of Kaltura.

Getting URL from YouTube

Follow these Steps:

1. Go to your **Course**.
2. If you already posted the video in your course, go to the module or section where you posted the video that needs the transcripts.
3. Find the video and click on the **YouTube** text, the video will open in a new window.
4. If not embedded in your course open the video directly from YouTube.
5. **Highlight** and **copy the URL** from the browser.

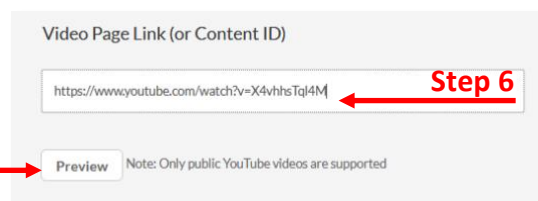
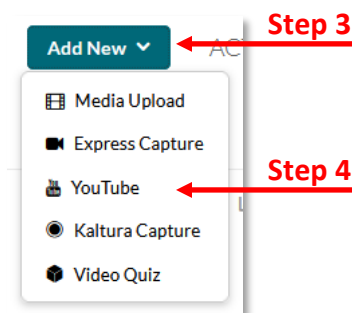


6. Go to the next step.

Uploading YouTube Videos to "My Kaltura"

Follow these Steps:

1. Go back to your Course.
2. Click **My Kaltura** on the left menu.
3. Click **Add New** on top right.
4. Select **YouTube**.
5. Select checkbox to "I agree to the above terms and conditions".
6. **Paste** the YouTube URL link in the *Video Page Link Box*.
7. Click **Preview**.
8. Scroll down and click **Save**.
9. Go back to **My Kaltura**.

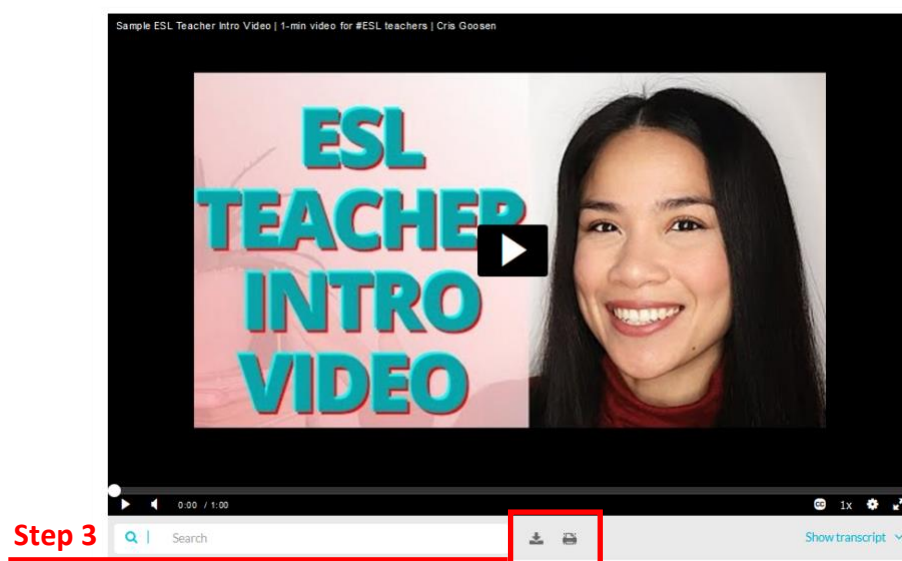


Note: Kaltura will start the rendering process of the video to auto generate the transcripts. This process could take between a couple of minutes to a couple of hours depending on the size of the video.

Downloading Transcripts

Follow these Steps:

1. After rendering is complete go back to [My Kaltura](#).
2. Open the video you just uploaded or the video you want to get transcripts for.
3. Click the [Download icon](#) or [Print icon](#) located just below the video.
 - a. The *Download icon* will give you a simple Text file that you can copy/paste to Word.
 - b. The *Print icon* will give you a PDF.



Note: Transcripts generated by Kaltura are 80% to 90% accurate. You will need to review the transcript document before uploading it to the course.
