


## Export Videos from Blackboard Collaborate Ultra

- 1) Open **Blackboard Collaborate Ultra** in your course.
- 2) Open the hamburger menu (the three horizontal lines).




3) Click the **Recordings** tab.



4) If you see the message that No recordings are found, click the down arrow for Filter by to expand.




5) Select **Recordings in A Range**.



6) Select the date of the recording or a range if necessary.




7) Click the small circle with horizontal dots.



8) Select Download.

- 9) Click **Ok** to save the video to your computer.
- 10) **Right Click** on the video and **Rename** each downloaded recording. It's a good idea to set up a clear directory structure that includes information like the course number, project title, a date, and some type of unique identifier.
