

## Sharing Content from a Physical Whiteboard in Teams

Microsoft Teams has a second camera sharing feature. If you have a physical whiteboard and a secondary camera connected to your computer, you can share the content that you write on the physical whiteboard in a Microsoft Teams meeting.

### Setting up the Camera

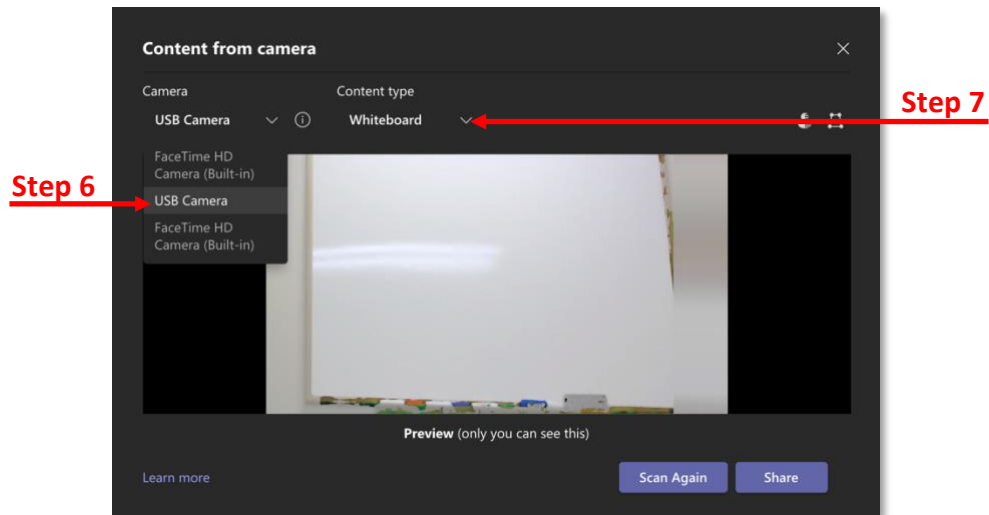
1. Connect the secondary web camera to your computer.
2. Point the camera to the whiteboard.

### Sharing Content from the Whiteboard

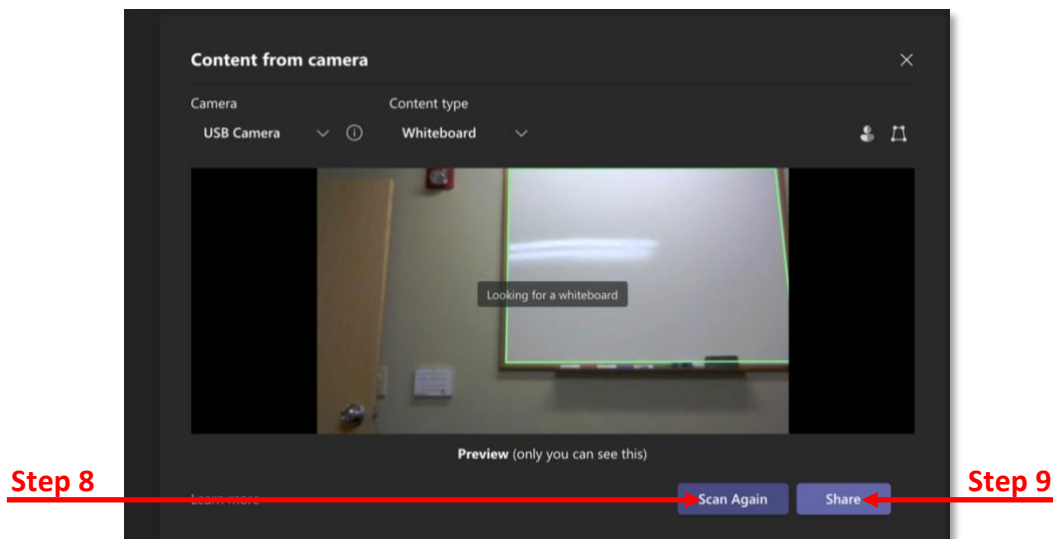
1. Start your Teams meeting.
2. Click the *Share content* button.
3. Click **Content from camera**.
4. Click **Whiteboard**.

5. Click **Got it** when the Share a whiteboard message appears.

6. Select **USB Camera** from the Camera dropdown menu.
7. Verify **Whiteboard** is selected for the Content type dropdown menu.



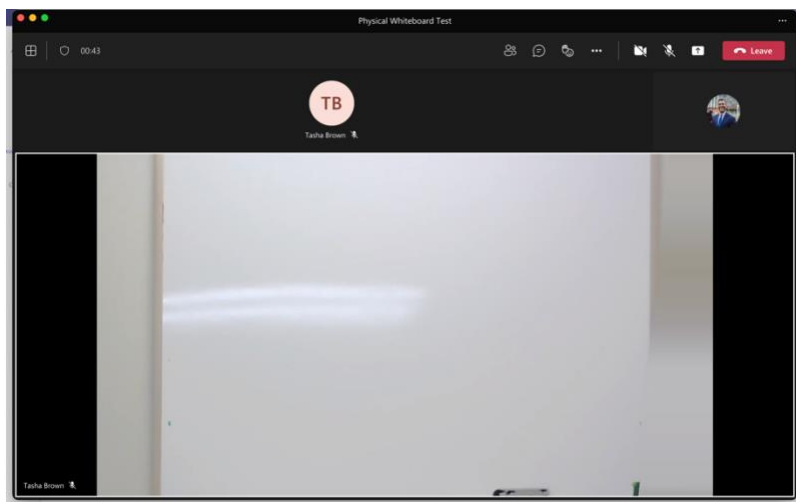
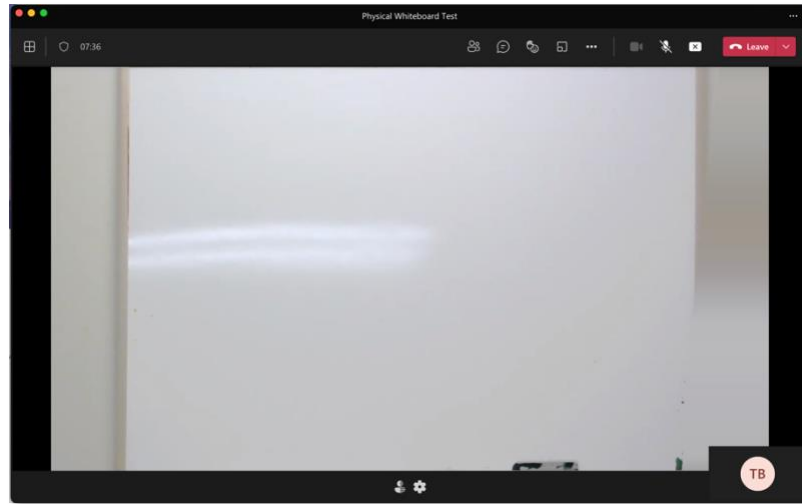
8. If you click **Scan Again**, the system will rescan to look for the whiteboard.
9. Once the system recognizes the camera, click **Share**. Now you can proceed with writing content on the whiteboard and it will appear for your audience.
